Whereas, The Detachment Mid-Year Conference is, in fact, the Detachment Executive Committee Meeting, therefore be it

Resolved, That Article VII, Section 1, Detachment Executive Committee be changed to add; *The Detachment Adjutant, Detachment Finance Officer, Detachment Chaplain, Detachment Historian, and Detachment Sergeant-at-Arms shall be members of the Committee, without vote. In the event the Immediate Past Detachment Commander shall be the National Executive Committeeman, or shall be deceased, or for any reason be ineligible to be a member of the Committee, or in the event the National Executive Committeeman shall fail for any reason to attend a meeting of the Committee, the Alternate National Executive Committeeman shall be a voting member of the Committee.*; and be it

Whereas, The Detachment of Colorado is a program of the Department of Colorado; and

Whereas, The Detachment of Colorado Constitution is not in compliance regarding Detachment Executive Committee authority between conventions; and

Whereas, The Detachment Mid-Year Conference is, in fact, the Detachment Executive Committee Meeting, therefore be it

Resolved, That Article IX, Section 1 be revised as follows: This Constitution may be amended at any Detachment Convention ~~or Mid-Year Conference~~ by a vote of two thirds (2/3) of the total authorized representation represented in person ~~or by proxy~~ provided that the proposed amendment shall have been submitted by resolution. All Resolutions, originating from a Squadron ~~the Detachment Executive Committee or a standing committee~~ shall be submitted in proper form at least forty-five (45) days prior to the Convention ~~or Mid-Year Conference~~ to the Detachment Adjutant. The Detachment Adjutant shall send notice of proposed changes to the Constitution to the Squadrons at least thirty (30) days prior to the convening of the next Detachment Convention ~~or Mid-Year Conference~~. The Constitution can also be amended by unanimous vote in favor of a properly introduced resolution to the above mentioned meeting.

Further Resolved, That this change become effective at the close of the Detachment Annual Convention.
